No.H1/I/1511/2022,- In exercise of the powers conferred under clause (d) of Section 2 and sub-section (2) of the Section 4 of the Minimum wages Act, 1948 (Central Act 11 of 1948), I, the Commissioner of Labour, Telangana, Hyderabad, and the Competent Authority under the Minimum Wages Act, 1948, hereby declare the average rise in the Consumer Price Index numbers for State Industrial Workers as well as State Agricultural Workers for the Half year ending December, 2022 i.e. as on 01-04-2023, is as follows in respect of the employments specified under Part-II in the Schedule.
