COST OF LIVING INDEX NUMBERS APPLICABLE TO THE EMPLOYEES EMPLOYED IN SCHEDULED EMPLOYMENTS AS ON 01-04-2023 - COST OF LIVING ALLOWANCE PAYABLE UNDER MINIMUM WAGES ACT, 1948.

No.H1/I/1511/2022.- In exercise of the powers conferred under clause (d) of Section 2 and sub-section (2) of the Section 4 of the Minimum wages Act, 1948 (Central Act 11 of 1948), I, the Commissioner of Labour, Telangana, Hyderabad, and the Competent Authority under the Minimum Wages Act, 1948, hereby declare the average rise in the Consumer Price Index numbers for State Industrial Workers as well as State Agricultural Workers for the Half year ending December, 2022 i.e. as on **01-04-2023**, is as follows in respect of the employments specified under Part-I and Part-II in the Schedule.

The Consumer Price Index numbers so notified in the Extra-ordinary Gazette came into force w.e.f. 01-04-2023.



Part-I (Industrial Workers) : Increase of 74 points from 1659 to 1733

Part-II(Agricultural Workers):Increase of 42 points from 1260 to 1302

These are applicable for the period from 01.04.2023 to 30.09.2023 in various Scheduled Employments notified under the Minimum Wages Act, 1948, in the State of Telangana for the purpose of calculation of Variable Dearness Allowance.
